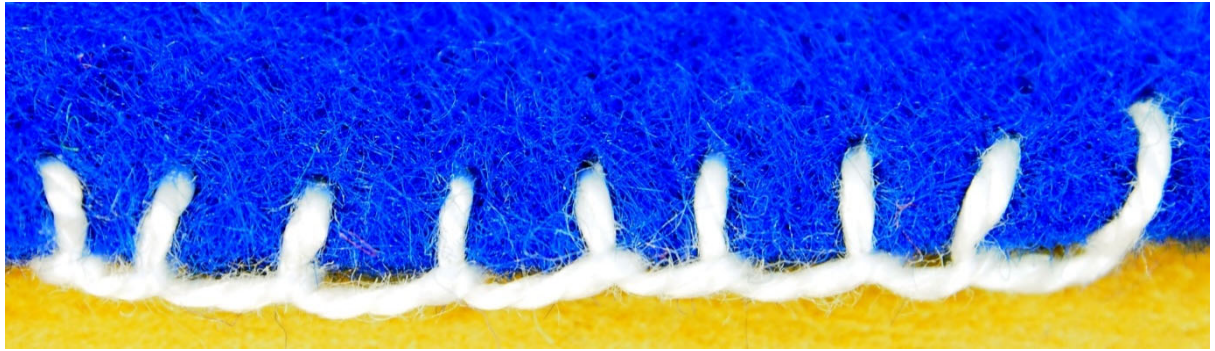


# How to do a Blanket Stitch (Hard)



1. Tie a knot at the end of your thread. This will stop you from pulling too much thread through.



2. Carefully line up the 2 pieces of felt.

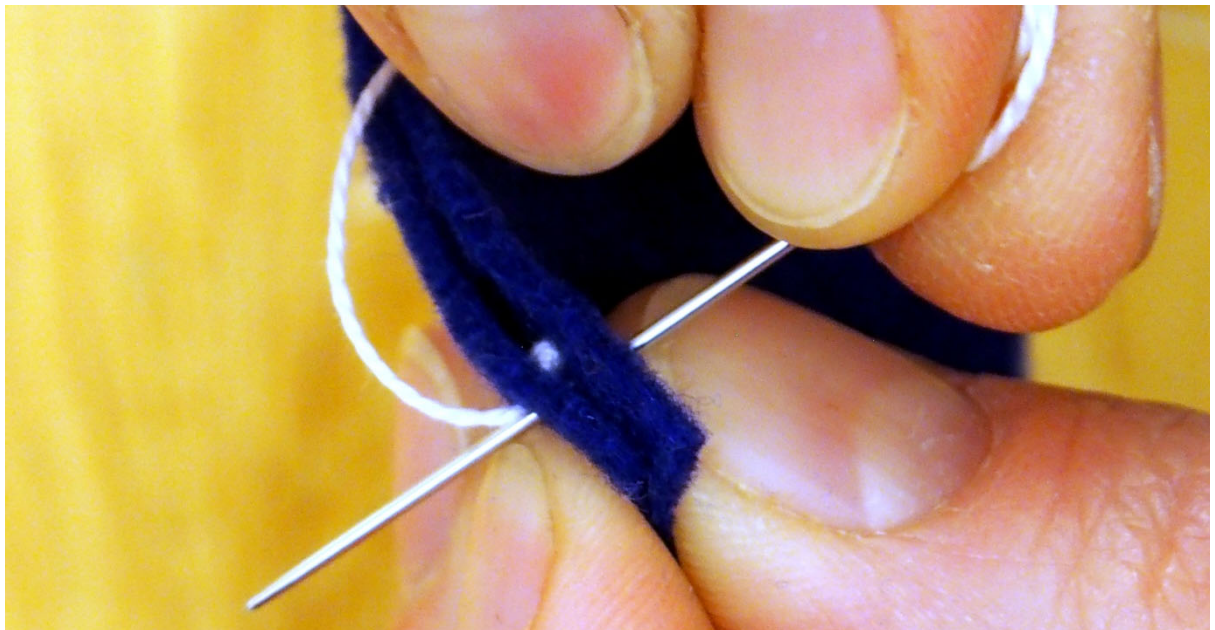


# How to do a Blanket Stitch (Hard)

3. From the inside of your felt, poke the needle and thread through 1 of the layers. Pull the needle and thread through until the knot stops you pulling more.

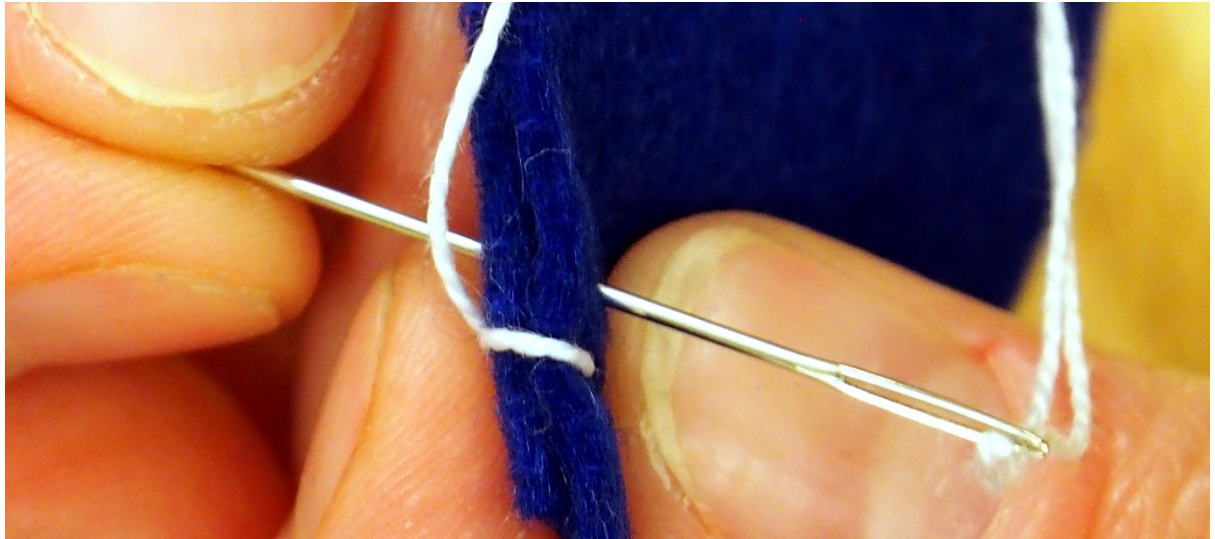


4. From the opposite side of your felt, push the needle and thread through both layers, right next to where you started. The thread should form a loop.



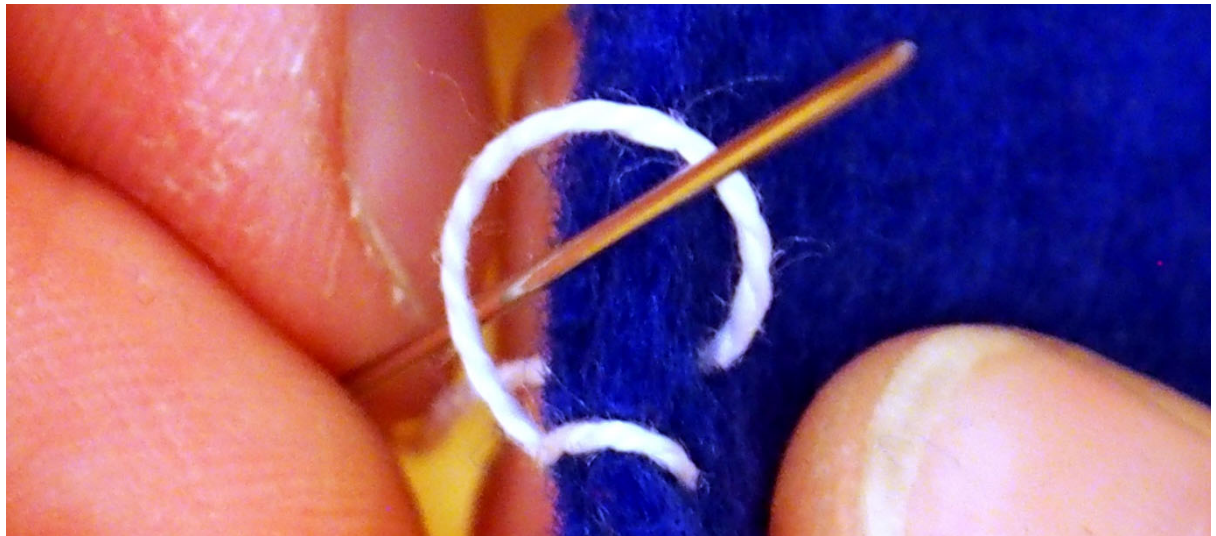
# How to do a Blanket Stitch (Hard)

5. Bring your needle and thread back around and push it through both layers of felt next to the first stitch. Don't pull the loop tight yet.



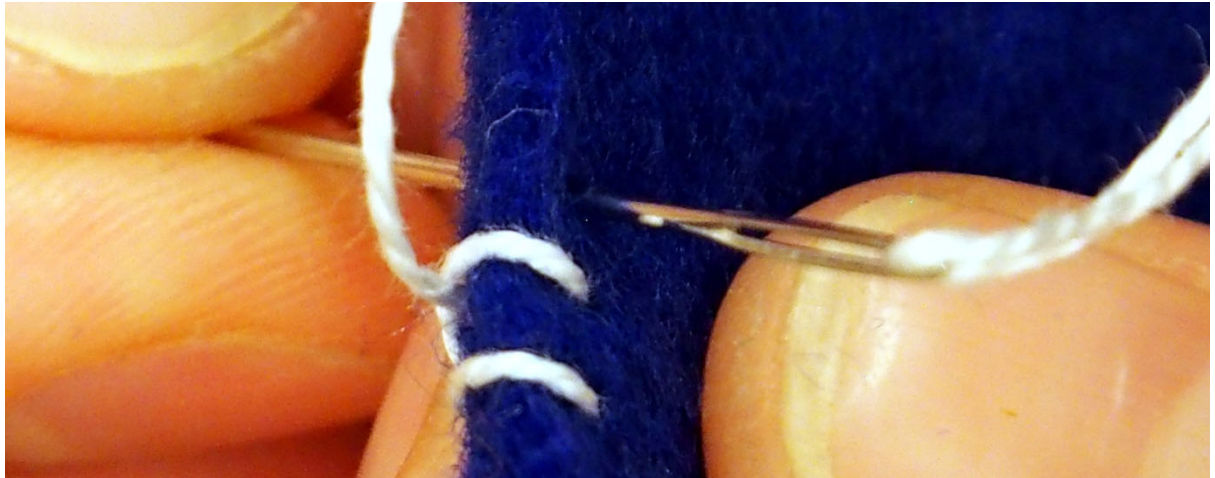
# How to do a Blanket Stitch (Hard)

6. Poke the needle and thread through the loop and now pull it tight.



# How to do a Blanket Stitch (Hard)

7. To make the next stitch, bring your needle and thread back around and push it through both layers of felt next to the first stitch. Like before, don't pull the loop tight yet.



8. Poke the needle and thread through the loop and pull it tight.
