Terms and Conditions

Who can enter:

All ages are welcome to submit artwork, professional or amateur.
Artists must live locally in East Anglia.

How to enter:

Complete an entry form, pay your fee and deliver or post your original artwork to EJaRt Creative Hasketon. (EJaRt Creative will not be held liable for any loss of work due to postal/courier services).

Submission Fee:

All submission fees are non-refundable. The fee must be paid Online via our Website or Cash/Card in Person, prior to your work being delivered (or when it is delivered) to EJaRt Creative.

£1 per entry

Only 1 entry per artist per season is allowed (maximum: 4 entries)

Theme:

Seasons

You are free to interpret this however you feel. Artwork should be recent or created specifically for the competition. Please be mindful that the calendar may be viewed by all age groups, children included.

Please note that artworks that are not sympathetic to the theme of the calendar will not be included. The curators of the calendar have final say on the artworks to be selected.

Delivery and Collection:

You must arrange to deliver and collect your artwork to the gallery.

Please ensure it is clearly labelled with your name.

At the time of collection, you should sign our collection register before you collect your artwork. We are unable to wrap any artworks.

Please note that you are submitting artwork at your own risk and we are not liable for any damage that may occur during the installation of your artwork or during the exhibition/competition.

Requirements for artwork/s:

To be able to be reproduced for the calendar, all artwork must be:

- unframed
- original
- landscape orientation
- no larger than A2 (w. 60cm x h. 42cm)
- 2D or 2D Relief
- in any medium

Please complete the entry form in full and ensure your artwork is clearly labelled on the back with the following:

- Age (if under 18)
- Title of your work
- Medium
- Month Entered For (please state ANY if you don't mind which)

Permission for promotional material:

By submitting artwork you agree to have your artwork photographed and shared via our social media channels/promotional advertisements regarding this event.

Permission for reproduction:

By submitting artwork you agree to have your artwork photographed and reproduced if it is selected as a Winner in the competition. You will be credited as the artist in the printed calendar. The original artwork still remains your personal property.

Shortlisted entries will be photographed for the website for voting purposes. An online exhibition of these artworks will remain on the website for the duration of the competition.

Availability of Artwork:

Winning Entries: Your original artwork must be available for the duration of the competition including the exhibition of winning entries.

Shortlisted Entries: Original artwork must be available until the Winning Entries for the Season entered are announced. After this time you may collect your work.

Unsuccessful Entries: Can be collected from EJaRt Creative once the shortlist has been announced.

Personal Data:
