
How to Make a Felt Decoration




- 1. You will need to use the templates to cut out the pieces for your chosen felt shape (See our template sheet).
- 2. Before sewing the sides of your felt shape together, you can embellish your decoration. Use a glue stick to attach any felt embellishment and then stitch around the edges. You can also sew on **Beads**, do **French Knots**, or sew on **Sequins**.







3. Carefully line up the 2 sides of your felt shape.



4. Sew the 2 sides of your decoration together but leave a gap to insert the stuffing. We have 3 stitching methods that you can try, **Running Stitch**, **Overcast Stitch** or **Blanket Stitch**.



5. Push the stuffing into the decoration. Use a pencil or chop stick to push the stuffing into all the gaps.

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6. To finish, sew the gap closed. Tie the end of your thread through the inside of one of the beginning stitches and cut off the excess thread.



7. You can stitch in a string or ribbon if your wish to hang your felt shape.
