

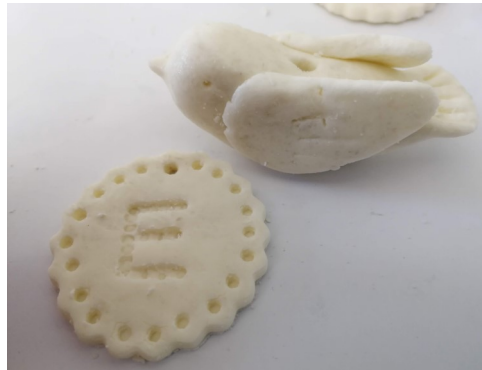
COLD PORCELAIN CLAY

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- 1/2 cup corn flour
- Just under 1/2 cup white PVA glue
- Petroleum jelly (Vaseline)
- Vinegar (optional)
- Mixing bowl
- Mixing utensil (lolly stick)
- Cling film

WHAT TO DO:

1. Put corn flour and glue into bowl and mix (this may take a little while).
2. Tip out the mix and knead it together to form a ball.
3. Add a small blob of Vaseline and knead into the mixture.
4. You are ready to start modelling or rolling out .
5. The cold porcelain will dry hard in about a week (depending on the thickness of your pieces and you can then paint it with acrylic paints).



TIPS AND EXTRA INFO.:

- **PRESERVE:** You can mix in a little vinegar to preserve the cold porcelain longer but it is not essential (especially if you are going to use it straight away/ in a few days).
- **STORAGE:** Wrap the mixture tightly with cling film (spread a thin layer of Vaseline onto the film surface to stop it sticking) and then put in an airtight container.
- **EXTRA:** You could use a drop of food colouring to make coloured batches of clay (but beware of staining surfaces and hands).
